The Role:

We are looking for a Front-End Web Developer who is motivated to combine the art of design with the science of programming. Responsibilities will include translation of the UI/UX design wireframes to actual code that will produce visual elements and user interaction of the application: you will work with the Design Team and bridge the gap between graphical design and technical implementation, taking an active role on both sides and defining how the application looks as well as how it works.

Responsibilities:

- Work closely with design, product management, and development teams to create elegant, usable, responsive and interactive interfaces across multiple devices
- Turning UI/UX designs into prototypes, creating excellent interactions from designs, writing reusable content modules and maintainability of the code.
- Implement UI development principles to ensure that the product client-side serves at scale
- Review and optimize the app usage by monitoring key metrics and rectifying the issues proactively



- Be able to perform well in a fast-paced environment and bring in optimal flow for rapidly changing design/technology

Skills and Qualifications:

- At least 3 years of relevant work experience as a web developer, UI developer, JavaScript expert or front-end engineer
- Proficient understanding of web front-end technologies, including HTML, CSS and JavaScript
- Understanding of server-side CSS pre-processing platforms, such as LESS and SASS
- Proficient understanding of client-side scripting and JavaScript frameworks, including React.js and Next.js
- Basic knowledge of image authoring tools, to be able to crop, resize, or perform small adjustments on an image. Familiarity with tools such as Sketch or Figma is a plus
- Proficient understanding of cross-browser compatibility issues and ways to work around them
- Proficient understanding of code versioning tools, including Git
- Good understanding of SEO principles and ensuring that application will adhere to them
- Knowledge of Scala and/or Ruby will be a plus

Things we are working on presently include:

- Rewriting our client side apps for performance and maintainability
- Integrating machine learning and data pipelines to categorise Creator's content
- Building a predictive search tool to match Creators with Brands
- Decomposing a monolithic platform and refactoring for scalability and agility

Our engineering principles include:
